Parent Information Night is on Tuesday, September 17th starting at 4:30pm in your child's homeroom classroom. See you there!



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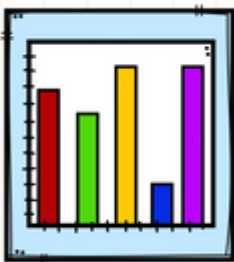
READING WORKSHOP

This week we begin to shift our focus in Reading Workshop. We still continue to read Kate DiCamillo's *The Tiger Rising* but we will begin to learn how to determine themes and big life lessons in fiction. We will learn how to learn how to use evidence from the text to ground our ideas, look beyond characters, and use different 'lenses' to think about our texts. As always we ask that your child is reading an enjoyable book for around 30 minutes each night. This is a very important aspect of reading development!



WRITING WORKSHOP

This week we are working on publishing our first piece of writing. We have come so far with our narrative writing since we began our unit. Once we have completed a published piece we will have an on-demand writing to apply and demonstrate what we have learned.



MATH

This week we'll be getting to the mid-module assessment. After that we'll be adding and subtracting multi-digit numbers. Student will be using their place value knowledge to decompose and compose numbers.



SOCIAL STUDIES
